Summary Narrative

On April 18, 2024, Idaho State Police Detective Victoria M. Gooch was assigned an investigation involving the Caldwell Chief of Police, Rex Ingram. The Canyon County Prosecutor, Bryan Taylor, received an anonymous letter containing allegations that Caldwell Chief of Police Rex Ingram was misusing public monies in his position as Chief of Police.

Bryan Taylor requested the Idaho State Police to conduct the investigation involving Rex Ingram.

Idaho State Police Lt. Colonel Bill Gardiner assigned this investigation to Detective Gooch.

Summary Narrative

On April 29, 2024, Idaho State Police Detective Victoria M. Gooch interviewed Caldwell Police Department Lt. Dave Wright regarding the allegations Caldwell Chief of Police Rex Ingram was misusing City of Caldwell funds under the pretense of attending training.

The interview of Lt. Dave Wright was audio recorded with his knowledge and consent and the thumb-drive containing the audio file was assigned Tag #240001674 (01) by the Tiburon Case Management System on May 04, 2024. The thumb-drive was then entered into evidence on May 04, 2024, by Detective Gooch.

Lt. Dave Wright advised in his interview he is responsible for reviewing all the financial transactions involving the Caldwell Police Department as part of his responsibilities, and that Chief Ingram has not misused any public monies while attending training, conferences, or funerals for fallen officers, including funerals outside the state of Idaho.

Narrative

1. On April 29, 2024, at approximately 9:27 a.m., myself, Idaho State Police Detective Victoria M. Gooch, interviewed Caldwell Police Department Lt. Dave Wright regarding the allegations Caldwell Chief of Police Rex Ingram was misusing City of Caldwell funds for personal reasons under the pretense of attending training.
2. The interview of Lt. Dave Wright was audio recorded with his knowledge and consent and the thumb-drive containing the audio file was assigned Tag #240001674 (01) by the Tiburon Case Management System on May 04, 2024. The thumb-drive was then entered into evidence on May 04, 2024, by me.
3. Lt. Dave Wright advised in his interview he is responsible for reviewing all the financial transactions involving the Caldwell Police Department as part of his responsibilities, and that Chief Ingram has not misused any public monies while attending training, conferences, or funerals for fallen officers, including funerals outside the state of Idaho.
4. Lt. Wright advised of the following regarding the allegations Chief Ingram has been misusing public monies:
5. Lt. Wright has been with the Caldwell Police Department for approximately 38 years.
6. He was the Acting Chief from January to July 2022, replacing Frank Wyatt, and Rex Ingram was then appointed as the Chief in July (2022).
7. He is the Executive Officer of the Caldwell Police Department assigned to the Chief of Police.
8. His duties include the following:
9. Paying all the bills for the department.
10. Fleet maintenance.
11. Building maintenance.
12. Radios, however, he is currently training someone new to take over these responsibilities.
13. Scheduling the Chief's calendar with the Chief's input.
14. He helps develop the budget.
15. And other duties as needed.
16. The Chief's former Administrative Assistant, Gabby Gudino, left the Caldwell Police Department approximately two weeks ago, and as a result, he has been moved into her office to assume the duties which were assigned to her, including maintaining the Chief's calendar.
17. When told the allegation involved a question about the Chief inappropriately using city funds to travel to training and other events, and the allegation also included the Chief's travelling for personal reasons, Lt. Wright stated, "The Chief travels a lot." However, Lt. Wright advised that the Chief has never traveled for personal reasons using city funds.
18. When asked about the expenditures involving the police department credit cards, Lt. Wright explained there are three credit cards assigned to the department; one for the Chief, one for the Deputy Chief (Shawn Sopoaga), and the third credit card is controlled by Lt. John Tucker for police department related purposes.

Narrative

19. Lt. Wright stated the Chief uses his credit card primarily for his own travel to training, conferences, and other events, as well as to pay vendors associated with police department.
20. He advised the Chief traveled to a funeral recently (March 11-12, 2024), of a law enforcement officer killed in the line of duty. He advised the Chief does not go to all the funerals for line of duty deaths, but in this case, the officer was a friend of the Chief's and he elected to go to his funeral.
21. Lt. Wright explained he approves all financial transactions associated with the department.
22. He further explained he signs all the documents related to the transactions, unless for example the bill is large (which he explained might be \$30,000.00 or \$40,000.00), and in that case, the Chief would sign, otherwise it would be his signature on the purchases or transactions.
23. When asked about what program the department uses for their financial records, he advised that it is called "Springbook," and that not only does the police department use the program, but the entire city of Caldwell uses the program. This program will have an itemized list of the Chief's travel expenses.
24. When asked who outside the police department approves the Chief's spending, he advised for all the department's spending, Scott Wallace reviews all the financial transactions involving the police department, as well as Rachelle Castleberry, who is the City of Caldwell Treasurer. He advised Mr. Wallace works for Ms. Castleberry.
25. Lt. Wright advised he has the authority to tell the Chief no to his spending, as well as employee-related issues, and that is because of his position within the PD.
26. Lt. Wright advised that each transaction is submitted individually.
27. When asked if the Chief made personal purchases with his department-issued credit card, he said no, but that recently, after Ada County Deputy Tobin Bolter was killed, while at the Command Post after this incident, the Chief used his department-issued credit card to purchase pizza for those stationed at the Command Post.
28. Lt. Wright advised that other people have access to all three credit cards because there is only the three and other staff members also are authorized to make purchases.
29. When asked if the department has the authority to write checks, he advised the department is authorized to write checks, and he then explained the approval process for doing so, which includes the involvement of the city council (which he specifically named Brad Doty and Chris Algood), the Treasurer, and eventually the approval reaches the level of the mayor. There is one council member assigned to the department for a year, which is a rotational position, and that council member reviews all the department purchases, including those made with a check.
30. When asked what the credit card would typically be used for, Lt. Wright explained for flights, motel, training, and per diem.
31. The Chief is required to submit the per diem amounts associated with the training requests for the times he travels, and he and Gabby Gudino would typically be the ones to submit the per diem amounts on behalf of the Chief.
32. When asked where I would find the information specific to the Chief's training requests, Lt. Wright advised that I should request the "Employee Relations Account."
33. Lt. Wright further explained that all transactions have multiple levels of approval, which would make it difficult to misuse the money allocated to the department because some of the levels of approval are outside of the department (including the City Council and the Mayor).
34. Lt. Wright advised that the Chief has brought some changes to the department, including a new "mounted (horse patrol) unit", as well as allowing department members to attend training and conferences outside of the state of Idaho to bring back different perspectives to the department, which Lt. Wright says he had not experienced that in his tenure at Caldwell PD until Chief Ingram became the Chief. Lt. Wright advised this has been a positive change for the department.

Narrative

35. When asked how I would be able to identify the transactions associated with the Chief's travel, Lt. Wright explained that any transactions associated with travel will be in three different accounts:

01-5-15-200-63220 "Honor Guard"

01-5-15-400-62900 "Employee Training"

01-5-15-100-66161 "Employee/Public Relations"

Also, he advised of an additional account, 10-5-15-100-62900 "Executive Staff Training".

36. He further advised that the department's budget covers October - the following October.

37. When he took his position as the Executive Officer at the Chief's request, Lt. Wright stated he told the Chief "He (Lt. Wright) would not do anything illegal, immoral, or unethical; and that it (whatever was asked of him) would have to be something that he would be able to explain to his wife and daughter."

38. Lt. Wright again was asked if the Chief traveled a lot, and he stated, "We all are now," "Everyone is traveling now within the department." He further explained the Chief is allowing anyone within the department to travel that wants to attend training or conferences. He explained they have sent department members to Florida for a specialized training and that the Chief is supportive of it.

39. I asked about the specific account(s) the department uses, and he advised there is only one account, and it is with U.S. Bank, and the Chief's credit card is associated with this account, as well as the two other credit cards. He advised the Chief's credit card number is [REDACTED]

40. Lt. Wright advised he has never witnessed the Chief use the credit cards used by Shawn (Sopoaga) or John (Tucker).

41. Lt. Wright advised the Chief's calendar will contain supportive information about the Chief's travel and the monetary transactions found in the bank statements.

42. In closing, Lt. Wright advised that the Chief took office in July 2022, so I would need to focus on the records after he took office; and the department uses the law enforcement records management system, Spillman, which will also have a record of the department's purchases. He further explained there is a monthly expenditure report that is generated every month, and he agreed to provide an example for me at a later date.

43. The interview was concluded at approximately 10:27 a.m. after it was determined that Lt. Wright had nothing further to provide.

Deputy Chief Sopoaga had been identified by Caldwell Mayor, Jarom Wagoner, as a department member who would be able to provide department-specific information relative to this investigation.

The interview was audio recorded with Deputy Chief Sopoaga's knowledge and consent and the thumb-drive of the audi file was assigned Tag#240001681(01) by the Tiburon Case Management System on May 05, 2024, and the thumb-drive was then entered into evidence on this same date by Detective Gooch.

Chief Deputy Sopoaga advised Chief Rex Ingram is not misusing public monies.

2. Deputy Chief Sopoaga had been identified by Caldwell Mayor, Jarom Wagoner, as a department member who would be able to provide department-specific information relative to this investigation.
3. The interview was audio recorded with Deputy Chief Sopoaga's knowledge and consent and the thumb-drive of the audio file was assigned Tag#240001681(01) by the Tiburon Case Management System on May 05, 2024, and the thumb-drive was then entered into evidence on this same date by me.
4. Deputy Chief Sopoaga was asked about an external hard drive currently housed in the former office of the Chief's Administrative Assistant, Gabriella Gudino.
5. Deputy Chief Sopoaga advised the Chief's calendar, as well as the credit card statements including the Chief's travel would be located on the hard drive. Chief Sopoaga was asked where the hard drive was located, and he advised Lt. Dave Wright has the hard drive.
6. Deputy Chief Sopoaga advised the Chief has one credit card issued to him for his use, and there are two additional credit cards issued to the department, however, he does not believe the Chief uses any other credit card other than the one issued to him.
7. When asked about the Steelhead Press Box being used for a "team building event", Deputy Chief Sopoaga advised that the money expended on the press box was a "Line Item" expense, meaning that it was approved by the Mayor and City Council. This expenditure of city monies is not under suspicion according to Deputy Chief Sopoaga.
8. I provided the anonymous letter to Deputy Chief Sopoaga, and he read the letter.
9. I then asked about the "Springbook" program the city uses and he advised the entire City of Caldwell uses this program and the department's financial records would be housed in this program. He advised the City of Caldwell Treasurer, Rachele Castleberry, would be able to provide access to the program for investigative purposes.
10. When asked if he has ever been concerned about the Chief's spending, he advised that he has never questioned the Chief's spending and he further explained there are numerous checks and balances in place that if there were an issue, it would have been discovered before the letter was sent.
11. He advised that a Captain with the department, Rob Rosen, who has been in his position for approximately one year, also reviews certain aspects of the department's expenditures.
12. Deputy Chief Sopoaga advised he and Lt. Dave Wright are responsible for the department's finances, and they are also responsible for making certain the department maintains their budget with respect to the expenditures.
13. When asked who would be responsible for providing me access to the records, Deputy Chief Sopoaga advised that I should ask the mayor about who would be responsible for providing me those records.
14. When asked which U.S. Bank Caldwell Police Department banks at, Chief Sopoaga advised that he does not know which of the branches the department uses as their primary branch.
15. Deputy Chief Sopoaga advised Chief Rex Ingram is not misusing public monies.
16. Deputy Chief Sopoaga had nothing further to provide and the interview was concluded at approximately 1:37 p.m. this same date.

- On July 02, 2024, at approximately 11:59 a.m., Idaho State Police Detective Victoria M. Gooch interviewed Caldwell Chief of Police Rex Ingram regarding allegations he misused City of Caldwell funds while in capacity as Chief of Police.
- The interview was audio recorded with Chief Ingram's knowledge and consent. The thumb drive of the interview was assigned Tag #240002471 (01) by the Tiburon Case Management System on July 03, 2024, and the thumb

drive was then entered into evidence this same date by me.

3. Chief Ingram was also advised of his Miranda rights, and he acknowledged he understood his rights and waived them to participate in the interview.

4. Chief Ingram advised he has been the Chief of Caldwell for the previous two years, and started his third year as chief yesterday, July 01, 2024.

5. Chief Ingram was asked about his Outlook calendar for the previous two years and he advised he had brought with him to the interview a copy of his Outlook calendar for the purpose of the interview.

6. When asked how many training trips he has take since his appointment as Chief, he advised he has attended approximately ten training sessions since he started as Chief in 2022.

7. When asked how many conferences he has attended since his appointment as Chief, he advised he has attended five to ten conferences. He emphasized in his interview that attended the conferences provides opportunities for him to promote change in his agency and to build the community trust that has been lost recently due to issues within Caldwell P.D.

8. Chief Ingram was asked why he took the Caldwell P.D. honor guard to California in October 2023 for a law enforcement officer's funeral, and he advised he is passionate about bringing attention to law enforcement officer related line of duty deaths; that his father, uncle, and father-in-law all served in law enforcement in California and had been shot in the line of duty. He worked to get the cheapest motel rates for the members of his honor guard, and he wanted to represent Caldwell P.D. at the funeral because the law enforcement member that died was someone with whom he had worked. He further explained he wanted to give his honor guard members the experience of attending a LEO's funeral since Idaho's incidence of law enforcement related line of duty deaths is low. He also had obtained permission from the Caldwell Mayor and City Council to take the honor guard to the California funeral.

9. I asked about the approval process for spending with Caldwell P.D. and he advised there is an extensive process associated with spending and that currently Caldwell City Councilman Chris Allgood is the council member assigned the oversight for the spending at Caldwell P.D. We discussed that Chris Allgood used to be the Chief of Caldwell P.D.

10. When asked if his and Shawn Sopoaga's wife traveled to Florida with them in November 2023 for the NIA graduation, he adamantly denied this and advised he went with Shawn, and their wives did not attend.

11. When asked about the purchase of the multiple gift card packs (\$500.00 for five \$100.00 gift cards) he advised he did not purchase the gift cards and that Lt. John Tucker did. He further explained the gift cards were purchased for an individual who was the victim of an excessive use of force by a Caldwell officer, whom the Chief had to terminate. He explained when the individual was asked about how Caldwell P.D. could resolve the issue, the individual advised he wanted a letter of apology and the ability to take his family out to dinner, so the decision was made to purchase the gift cards to a restaurant for this individual. The purchase of the gift cards was an effort to avoid potential litigation brought by the officer's conduct. He suggested I interview John Tucker about the purchase of the gift cards.

12. When asked about multiple purchases of airline tickets, Chief Ingram explained there are times when his work-schedule changes and he must cancel trips; the conference or training he is scheduled to attend makes changes to their itinerary's; or he must adjust his schedule around. He advised that he frequently flies Alaska Airlines and because he is a regular customer, he can get refunded for flights that he has had to cancel, or he uses the credit on a flight he was unable to use for another flight at a future time.

13. Regarding the June 2023 trip to California to pick up the Animal Control vehicle, he advised Lt. Dave Wright was scheduled to go down to Southern California to retrieve the truck, and the Chief was already scheduled to be in Southern California at the same time, so he volunteered to drive the truck back with Lt. Wright. He advised the return trip took twenty hours to drive the truck back from Southern California to Caldwell.

14. In March 2023, he attended the Western State's Sheriff's Association conference with Shawn Sopoaga and

they both were in Reno March 05-09, 2023.

15. Chief Ingram advised there are times he does not claim per diem.

16. The next issue we discussed was the Apple account purchases. He advised he went to subscribe to an Apple account using the cell phone used by the previous Chief, and when he subscribed, the phone automatically entered the Caldwell City credit card stored in the cell phone. He explained that he told Gabby Gudino, his Administrative Assistant about this mistake, and he thought it had been taken care of, but he was advised it had not been.

He explained he has an Instagram account through Apple, for using it as a platform to keep the public informed about Caldwell P.D., and one of the accounts is to be able to listen to music. He advised he has never transferred the account to his personal account, and that the Apple accounts he uses have been maintained through his work at Caldwell P.D.

17. When I asked the Chief why he believed he was put in the situation where he was under investigation, he advised he was hired to reform the Caldwell Police Department, because of a history of issues within the agency, and as a result, he has had to hold people accountable and that has resulted in some positive outcomes and some negative outcomes. He had a "spotless" record in his extensive law enforcement career, including his time at L.A.P.D., and one of the people he has had to hold accountable has resulted in these allegations. Also, he explained the agency has been experiencing some growing pains, and this has caused stress for some of the agency members.

18. Chief Ingram advised he has never misused public funds.

19. When asked how many trips his wife, Venissa, had taken with him when he traveled for work, her advised she had been on two trips with him (Florida in January-February 2023; and Washington D.C. in May 2024). However, at approximately 7:30 p.m. this same date, Chief Ingram called me and advised his wife had just reminded him she had also gone to the International Association of Chiefs of Police (IACP) in San Diego, California with him for a conference October 13-18, 2023. On all the trips his wife has gone with him, he has paid out of his own pocket for her travel and expenses.

20. When asked about the purchase of the Christmas party tickets for his wife and Shawn Sopoaga's wife to go, he advised they were expected to go to this event, and the tickets were paid for by Caldwell P.D. because the function was sponsored by a law enforcement organization that represents law enforcement retirees and current active members in states including Idaho, Nevada, and California.

21. The interview was concluded at approximately 12:49 p.m. this same date after it was determined the Chief had nothing further to provide.

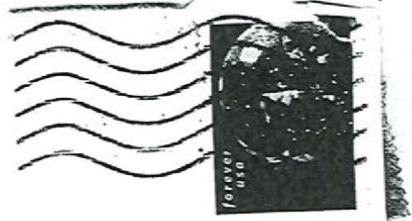

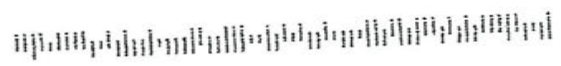

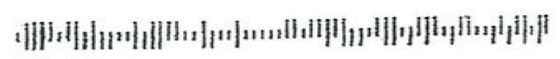

Other – Additional thing to be aware of:

- Most transactions on the General Ledger Detail cannot be tied to transaction on the statements based on the amount. Additionally, it is unknown where the JE dates originate from.
 - Many transactions for food, events, and sponsorships – Unknown if there are spending limits or if documentation is required to support a business purpose and attendees.
 - Various other questions came up but were not specific to expense and an event attended by Mr. Ingram.

Flagged transactions are based on my understanding of what is allowed under the positions and agencies I have worked for. A review of Caldwell Police Department's policies and procedures may show that these are allowable transactions and Mr. Ingram's position may follow a different set of expenditure rules which I am not aware of.

RE: Idaho State Police Misuse of Public Moneys by Public Officers Investigation on City of Caldwell Chief of Police Rex Ingram

Based on an anonymous letter and upon the request of Bryan Taylor, Canyon County Prosecuting Attorney, on April 18, 2024, the Idaho State Police (hereinafter "ISP") opened an independent investigation involving the City of Caldwell Chief of Police Rex Ingram (hereinafter "Chief Ingram"). Specific allegations included alleged violations of Idaho Code § 18-5701, Misuse of Public Moneys by Public Officers and Public Employees. Pursuant to a memorandum of understanding with Prosecuting Attorney Taylor, which was executed on May 7, 2024, I, the Boise County Prosecuting Attorney, have been appointed as the Special Prosecuting Attorney, in order to avoid the slightest appearance of impropriety and to promote public confidence in the outcome of such investigation.

A detective with ISP diligently started said investigation, which at that time, included conducting interviews with Lieutenant Dave Wright and Deputy Chief Soporoga of the City of Caldwell Police Department (hereinafter "the Department"). These two witnesses fully cooperated with the investigation, and suggested other additional evidence to collect. The evidence presented at that time facially raised some questions,

and in response, a *Subpeona Duces Tecum* was issued and served upon the legal counsel of the City of Caldwell, which was promptly complied with.

Specific evidence was collected as a result of this subpoena, including but not limited to: master outlook calendars of Chief Ingram and the Department, the hard drive of an administrative assistant from the Department, a vendor master list of the Department, records of Department financial accounts, credit card numbers and financial statements associated with cards assigned to Chief Ingram, travel records and the like of Chief Ingram, as well as Department policies applicable to travel. This physical evidence corroborated that there exists a multi-level approval system for all expenditures made by Chief Ingram.

In an effort to be as thorough as possible, this voluminous evidence was reviewed by the ISP detective, who immediately took additional steps to consult with the Idaho Department of Finance to conduct an independent forensic audit. This audit again presented new facial questions. In an effort to answer those questions, Chief Rex Ingram and Lieutenant John Tucker were interviewed. These two individuals fully cooperated with the investigation, and it should be noted that Chief Ingram was read his rights in a criminal investigation under *Arizona v. Miranda*, and he knowingly, intelligently, and voluntarily waived his right to have legal counsel present during the interview.

Evidence collected at this stage again answered the more recent outstanding questions, specifically that public funds that were used did not include compensating non-law enforcement personnel, such as spouses, through airfare, lodging, or vehicle rental costs, and there were some charges that appeared personal in nature, specifically a music streaming service.

In looking at Idaho Code § 18-5701, Misuse of Public Moneys by Public Officers and Public Employees, no public officer or public employee shall:

- (1) Without authority of law, appropriate public moneys or any portion thereof to his own use, or to the use of another; or
- (2) Loan public moneys or any portion thereof; or, having the possession or control of any public moneys, make a profit, directly or indirectly out of public moneys, or use public moneys for any purpose not authorized by law; or
- (3) Fail to keep public moneys in his possession until disbursed or paid out by authority of law when legally required to do so; or
- (4) Deposit public moneys or any portion thereof in any bank, or with any banker or other person, otherwise than on special deposit, or as otherwise authorized by law; or
- (5) Change or convert public moneys or any portion thereof from coin into currency, or from currency into coin or other currency, without authority of law; or
- (6) Knowingly keep any false account, or make any false entry or erasure in any account of or relating to public moneys; or fraudulently alter, falsify, conceal, destroy or obliterate any such account; or
- (7) Willfully refuse or omit to pay over, on demand, any public moneys in his hands, upon the presentation of a draft, order or warrant drawn upon such public moneys by competent authority; or
- (8) Willfully omit to transfer public moneys when such transfer is required by law; or
- (9) Willfully omit or refuse to pay over to any public officer, employee or person authorized by law to receive the same, any public moneys received by him under any duty imposed by law so to pay over the same; or
- (10) Knowingly use any public moneys, or financial transaction card, financial transaction card account number or credit account issued to or for the benefit of any governmental entity to make any purchase, loan, guarantee or advance of moneys for any personal purpose or for any purpose other than for the use or benefit of the governmental entity.

Other provisions of Idaho Code, Title 18, Crimes and Punishments, were additionally analyzed, which expanded the scope of the original request in order to comprehensively promote public confidence, including but not limited to, Chapter 13, Bribery and Corruption, as well as, Chapter 36, Forgery and Counterfeiting.

Starting with Idaho Code § 18-5701, Misuse of Public Moneys by Public Officers and Public Employees, several subsections are clearly inapplicable, including

subsections 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, and 9, as there was no allegation or evidence of any public money being deposited in an account, converted to other currency, Chief Ingram keeping a false account, willfully refusing or omitting payment or transfer. The other provisions of Idaho Code, Title 18, that were analyzed are clearly inapplicable as well. For brevity's sake, all inapplicable portions are not analyzed for the purpose of this letter.

When looking at the evidence, there are essentially two different classification of expenditures that facially raised questions under Idaho Code § 18-5701(1-2) and (10). The first classification, was expenditures discussed in the interviews with Lieutenant Dave Wright and Deputy Chief Soporoga, which involved line budget items, including the Department's Honor Guard, Employee Training, Employee/Public Relations, and Executive Staff Training. The second classification involved expenditures that facially appeared to be for non-law enforcement purposes, which includes expenditures like spouses being listed on travel documents or personal music services.

Starting with this first classification of expenditures, the line budget items, the ISP detective collected evidence that these line budget items involved a multiple level approval process. If there was an expenditure through a Department credit card, which the Chief Ingram has and utilized, there is a correlating credit card statement that is produced by a third party financial institute, where after the Department received it, the purchasing individual would submit a requisition form for each individual transaction. After that, Lieutenant Dave Wright, who is the Executive Officer of the Department, would review the credit card statement and ensure that each transaction has its own requisition form. Lieutenant Wright would then approve or deny such expenditure. That information would be entered into a City of Caldwell financial system known as "Springbrook". From

there, a deputy treasurer and/or the City of Caldwell Treasurer would review the transaction, who would then approve or deny such expenditure. If there was a check to be drafted by Chief Ingarm or the Department, the proposed check, amount, and payee, would then be emailed to the Treasurer, all of City of Caldwell Council Members, and the Mayor for review. At the following City Council meeting, the check would be approved or denied on the public record, in further compliance with Idaho Code Title 74, Transparent and Ethical Government, Chapter 2, Open Meetings Law. Evidence shows that no other form of payment is possible for Chief Ingram.

Inherent in this multi-level approval policy for every expenditure of Chief Ingram is the review of every person to ensure that the expenditures are for the use or benefit of the governmental entity, the City of Caldwell Police Department. Such stringent use of this policy ensures that any appropriation of public moneys is consistent with the laws of the State of Idaho. As such, no evidence exists that on this classification of expenditures by Chief Ingram that there was any violation of Idaho Code § 18-5701, Misuse of Public Moneys by Public Officers and Public Employees.

Turning to the second classification involving expenditures for facially non-law enforcement personnel/purposes, the ISP detective collected evidence of Chief Ingram's credit card expenditures, which included invoices of airfare, lodging, and vehicle rental costs with non-law enforcement personnel names. Further evidence showed that all expenditures involving non-law enforcement personnel involved online travel booking accounts, where it appeared Chief Ingram used an account which innocuously and inadvertently auto-populated to include his spouse. The cost and duration of these expenditures match with only Caldwell Police Department personnel attending

Department sanctioned law enforcement training or employee/public relations events, such as law enforcement officer funerals who fell in the line of duty. As such, I have concluded that based on the evidence, these expenditures from Chief Ingram did not actually appropriate public monies to non-law enforcement personnel to attend, so there was no violation of Idaho Code § 18-5701, Misuse of Public Moneys by Public Officers and Public Employees.

Finally, there was an expenditure for one month of a personal music streaming service. The ISP detective uncovered evidence that this one time transaction was automatically charged by the service provider, which inadvertently utilized the Department's credit card, as it was a saved credit card on Chief Ingram's phone. Chief Ingram promptly notified his assistant within thirty minutes of receiving notice of such error. Idaho Code § 18-5701, Misuse of Public Moneys by Public Officers and Public Employees, requires a specific intent to actually "appropriate", "use", and/or "knowingly use" public moneys. Due to the inadvertent nature of such expense, there was no requisite specific intent to use such moneys, so there has been no violation of Idaho Law. This is further evidenced by Chief Ingram immediately notifying another, and I would note such de minimis cost has been repaid by Chief Ingram.

Based on my analysis of the evidence in this case, and the legal framework in the State of Idaho, I conclude that the City of Caldwell Chief of Police Rex Ingram did not violate Idaho Code § 18-5701, Misuse of Public Moneys by Public Officers and Public Employees. Therefore, based upon the Idaho Rules of Professional Conduct, specifically Rule 3.8(a), I am declining prosecution in this matter. The multiple level approval system with documentation shows that any expenditure was independently approved to be an

appropriate use of public monies for the use and benefit of the Caldwell Police Department. Additionally, any mention of non-law enforcement personnel was inadvertent, where public monies was not appropriated on their behalf, and the one time transaction for personal music streaming was inadvertent and repaid. This letter serves as the final disposition in this matter, and the Boise County Prosecutor's Office review of this matter is now closed.

Missing Calendar – Mr. Ingram’s calendars were not provided for the dates listed below and expenses could not be verified with corresponding events.

Missing Invoices – Many expenses did not have supporting documents or the documents provided were receipts/reservations which did not indicate what was specially purchased.

Other – Additional thing to be aware of:

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- Most transactions on the General Ledger Detail cannot be tied to transaction on the statements based on the amount. Additionally, it is unknown where the JE dates originate from.
 - Many transactions for food, events, and sponsorships – Unknown if there are spending limits or if documentation is required to support a business purpose and attendees.
 - Various other questions came up but were not specific to expense and an event attended by Mr. Ingram.

Flagged transactions are based on my understanding of what is allowed under the positions and agencies I have worked for. A review of Caldwell Police Department's policies and procedures may show that these are allowable transactions and Mr. Ingram's position may follow a different set of expenditure rules which I am not aware of.
